Personal items	Risk of being misplaced or stolen	Medium	Remove personal possessions to secure location	Low
Public entering the building during the event	Children coming into contact With adults they don't know	High	CCToddlers team member on the door from when the event opens for registration.	Low

High	Having a CCToddlers Team member on the door throughout the event. Parent/carer responsible for their children. Reminded verbally and having a notice displayed to state this too.	Low
Families not aware who leaders are during the event	Families may approach other parents rather than CCToddlers team for help and support	Medium	All CCToddler team to wear Cromer Church volunteer lanyard for the duration of the event. All team will also wear a CCToddlers polo shirt once these have arrived Leader to explain to those who are attending that if they need help of any kind, they need to speak to someone in a Cromer Church volunteer lanyard. All CCToddlers team will be DBS checked	Low
Burns and scalds	Cups of coffee and tea for carers being spilt or knocked over near children	high	Use plastic cups with lids	low
Allergies	Children or adults coming into contact with identified allergy items	High	Ask for any allergies to be recorded on the registration form and also on the register. The named first aider to check all the registration forms and communicate the allergies to the leader(s) of the event and to team members where allergies need to be taken into consideration eg caterer	Low
