

Selection of two new Mission Partners 2026-2028

Three organisations were nominated to be our new Mission Partners 2026-2028, and it is now time for the church family to vote and select which two should be added to the list of Mission Partners.

The three nominations are: **Mission Without Borders** (nominated by Anne Attfield), **Nationwide Christian Trust** (nominated by Pelham Clark) and **Teso Development Trust** (nominated by Frances Britton).

The completed nomination forms giving brief information about the organisations and what it would mean to have them as a Mission Partner will be displayed at the Parish Church and St Martin's from this weekend until 30th November. Please also pray about which of the nominated organisations should be selected.

Members of the Cromer Church family vote to make the selection. Each person can vote once and can vote for **up to two** of the organisations.

There are two ways to vote:

- **Voting papers and ballot boxes will be available at St Martin's and the Parish Church during services on Sundays 16th, 23rd and 30th November and on Wednesday mornings 19th and 26th November** when Cornerstone is open. Please follow the instructions on the voting paper and place it in the ballot box.
- You can also vote by **sending an email with your votes to the PCC Secretary** (pccsecretary@cromer-church.org.uk).

Voting ends at 8.00 p.m. on Sunday 30th November.

The votes will then be counted and the names of the newly-selected Mission Partners published in the Weekly Update and announced at the Parish Church and St Martin's.

Our current Mission Partners – to which the new organisations will be added – are: Michelle Proctor, Bible Society, Good News for Everyone (formerly Gideons), Church Pastoral Aid Society (CPAS) (our Patron), London City Mission, Canaan Christian Trust and Tearfund. Support for our Mission Partners involves prayerful, financial and practical support and engagement with their work and is an important part of our mission effort. Please play your part by reading the nominations, asking questions, getting involved and, above all, by voting.
