## Cromer Parish Church

**A church building has stood on this site at the heart of Cromer for well over 600 years.** Built to the glory of God, the church is a gathering place where members of the local and visiting Christian family meet with each other and with God; are built up and encouraged in their faith; and are equipped and sent out to live as God's people: serving Him and serving the world. This has been the purpose of Cromer Church for the last 600 years and remains its main purpose today.

Every year, we are privileged to welcome thousands of visitors to the church building. It is our hope that, as you look around, you will value and feel at home in this place where God has been worshipped for hundreds of years and enjoy the peace, presence and love of God that you experience here.

During the summer season, members of the Church are on hand to welcome you, talk with you, answer any questions and pray with you, if that would be helpful. Guidebooks, information leaflets, Bibles, other books, cards and gifts are available from our bookstall.

We hope that you will experience something of the reality of the Living God, who we know and serve, and will consider joining us at one of our services at the Parish Church or at St Martin's, the details of which can be found inside this leaflet. We have traditional and modern services each Sunday and, whatever your age, background or experience, you'd be very welcome at any of them.

Cornerstone Coffee Shop serves drinks and light refreshments and is open in the Parish Church, 10.00 to 4.00, Monday to Friday, between May and October (then in the Parish Hall on Monday, Wednesday and Friday (10.00-12.00) and Thursday (10.00-2.00)).

We know that a lot of people look forward to climbing the tower when they visit but that isn't possible at the moment as we have a pair of Peregrine Falcons nesting on the roof. Peregrines are protected birds and it is an offence to disturb their nest site. We expect the tower to be closed until at least the end of July but, except during service times, a CCTV monitor is available to enable visitors to watch the Peregrines on their nest.

Once the tower re-opens, it will be open 10.30 to 4.30 Monday to Friday and 11.00 to 4.00 on Saturday (unless the church is in use) until 26th October. The tower is the tallest in Norfolk - with more than 170 steep, stone, spiral steps - and the view from the top is terrific.

In August, we play our part in Cromer Carnival, with a special service on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> and our own float in the Carnival Parade on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup>. The following week, we take part in the Scripture Union Beach Mission.

We hope that you will enjoy your visit to Cromer and to this beautiful part of Norfolk. Please take the opportunity to pray, to be still and to allow yourself to be refreshed by God, who loves you and cares for you always.
